St. Peter Church in Gueydan has always been a place of worship for our community. For many years members of St. Peter Catholic Church in Gueydan, LA with limited mobility have been asking for our church parish to install handrails on the ramps on the east and west entrances to the church. Unfortunately, the church parish has never had the resources to install proper handrails. This year we will put forth a valiant effort to have the handrails constructed and installed through the generosity of donors to the "I Give Catholic Campaign" beginning on December 2, 2025. The handrails will be constructed locally out of heavy-duty aluminum, and will span the entire length of the east and west entrance ramps of the church. The handrails will be installed on each side of the ramps. We hope the handrails will serve as a welcoming symbol to greet all parishioners, especially those needing assistance entering and leaving the church and those that have previously not been able to attend Mass in the past due to the lack of appropriate banisters. Efforts of previous "I Give Catholic Campaigns" have been successful due to the good and faithful hearts of the generous donors in the past years, and we sincerely hope and pray that this year will be no different. So, we ask that you please help our church parish and help our parishioners with limited mobility to enter and leave St. Peter Catholic Church safely by donating to this year's "I Give Catholic Campaign," as we can all be a part of answering their prayers.


## Vocation awareness week November 2-8.
