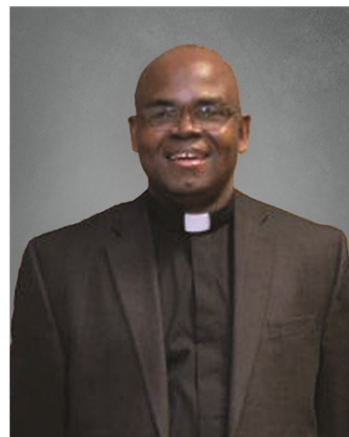

### Fr. Peter Igwilo

Father Peter Igwilo, BCC, MA, M Ed, Ph D, is a priest of the Catholic Diocese of Ekwulobia, Nigeria, and was ordained to the priesthood in 1992. Fr. Igwilo, a priest chaplain/senior priest in charge of the Catholic Ministry in the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Wilmington, Delaware. Fr. Igwilo pastored in two growth-oriented churches in Nigeria for ten years. In August 2002, his bishop sent him on a mission assignment to the U.S. Fr. Peter works for the Veterans Affairs Hospital in Wilmington, Delaware, with the affiliation and faculties of the Archdiocese of the Military Services. He is a priest chaplain in the chaplain service of the hospital, where he specializes in post-traumatic stress disorder and moral injuries.


